

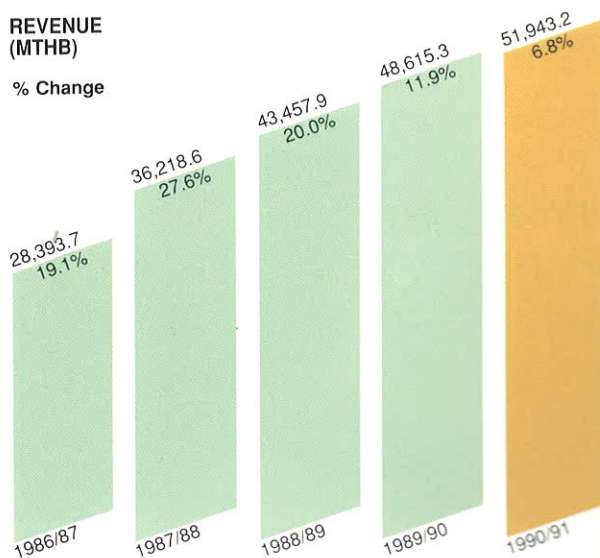


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HIGHLIGHTS 1990/91

- Twenty-seventh consecutive year of profit.
- Record gross revenue, 51,943.2 million Baht, the highest ever achieved.
- Record cargo carried – 863.6 million revenue freight ton-kms. THAI is now one of the top twenty cargo airlines of the world.
- Nine new aircraft purchased for THAI fleet – which now totals 60.
- THAI fleet records lowest ever average age of aircraft: 5.64 years.
- THAI's Technical Department achieves capability to completely overhaul A300-B4 aircraft type for other airlines.
- Construction commenced on new Domestic Flight Kitchen in Bangkok.
- THAI introduces bar-coded, computerised baggage tag control system in Bangkok.
- New First and Executive Class luxury passenger lounges opened in Bangkok, Hong Kong, Singapore and Kathmandu.
- THAI's shares approved for listing on the Securities Exchange of Thailand, July 1991, in preparation for offering to public during 1992.
- THAI becomes full partner of AMADEUS Global Travel Distribution, in July 1991, to establish computerised information and reservation system covering 30,000 outlets worldwide.
- THAI joins private oil companies and other state enterprises to set up Bangkok's Fuel Pipeline Transportation Ltd.
